

Latest COVID-19 update to visitors [12th of March, 2020]

List of COVID-19 high-risk countries has been extended by National Centre of Public Health and now includes: China, North Italy (all country), Hong Kong, Iran, Japan, South Korea, Singapore, France, Spain, Germany.

Following recommendations from the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Lithuania and National Centre of Public Health regarding self-isolation periods for persons exposed to the risk of infection with coronavirus (COVID-19), Lithuanian University of Health Sciences strongly recommends the following to potential university visitors:

1. Visitors coming from (or visited in the last 14 days, or crossing) China, North Italy, (**all country**), Hong Kong, Iran, Japan, South Korea, Singapore **France, Spain, Germany** are strongly advised to cancel their visits or plans to visit LSMU;
2. In case of unavoidable travel and being exposed to the risk according to the clause 1 above, visitors shall inform LSMU International Relations Office by email Zivile.Kepezinskiene@lsmu.lt about their travel details and follow the latest updates and recommendations in the webpages of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Lithuania <http://sam.lrv.lt> and [National Centre of Public Health http://nvsc.lrv.lt](http://nvsc.lrv.lt);
3. Visitors exposed to the risk of infection with coronavirus (COVID-19) are obligated to register at the National Centre of Public Health : <http://nvsc.lrv.lt/korona-eng> before entering Lithuania.
