RECTOR'S ORDER**

**REGARDING THE CHANGE OF THE ORDER OF ORGANIZATION OF THE STUDY
PROCESS DURING THE QUARANTINE**

In accordance with the amendment of Resolution No. 1364 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 7 December “Regarding Resolution No. 1226 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 4 November 2020 “Regarding the declaration of quarantine in the territory of the Republic of Lithuania,” I partially amend Order No. V-362 of 28 October 2020 “Regarding organization of the study process during quarantine,” and I reword clause 1 as follows:

1. I s e t o u t from 9 until 31 of December 2020 to carry out LSMU studies only remotely: theoretical classes and exams thereof, practical classes (laboratory works, exercises and practice to be performed remotely) and to carry out exams thereof remotely. Internships envisioned in the study programs, which cannot be carried out remotely (clinical medical practice (internship), clinical practice in midwifery nursing and care (2nd year), midwifery practice 2 (4th year), nursing practice III and V, 2nd year nursing model clinical practice, advanced nursing practice, pharmacy professional practice in pharmacies) shall continue to be organized in accordance with the procedure established at the internship bases and the LSMU temporary description of the procedure for organizing distance learning of clinical medicine internships (valid during the quarantine and emergency situation due to the COVID-19 pandemic in the Republic of Lithuania), approved by Rector’s Order No. V-723 of 1 December 2020, in compliance with the established conditions of public health, hygiene and using the necessary personal protective equipment.

1.2. In case of changes in the decisions of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania regarding management of the COVID-19 pandemic to consider and apply other methods of conducting studies.

2. I n s t r u c t the Head of the Document Management Service, Justina Mačiulskienė, to acquaint the deans of the faculties, heads of the departments, and study administrators with the Order.

3. I e n t r u s t control of the execution of the Order to the Vice-Rector for Studies Professor Kęstutis Petrikonis.

4. The Order shall e n t e r i n t o f o r c e on the date of its signature.
