



TRAVELERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BE PREPARED FOR INSPECTIONS AT AIRPORTS AND SEAPORTS

IT IS REQUIRED

To fill in a questionnaire <https://keleiviams.nvsc.lt/en/form> for travelers and have a proof of the completed electronic questionnaire, the so-called QR code.



IT IS REQUIRED

If the test was done 48 hours before arrival, one shall have the supporting documents. If the person plans to get tested in Lithuania, it is recommended to register in advance for the test at the CORONA hotline 1808****



IT IS REQUIRED

If the person has recovered from the disease, it is required to present a certificate from a medical institution at the airport or seaport stating that the COVID-19 disease has been diagnosed by getting a laboratory test not earlier than 90 days before returning/arriving in Lithuania.



IT IS REQUIRED

If the person has been vaccinated, he/she shall present the documents at the airport or seaport proving that it has been done following the full vaccination scheme.



******If passengers have not done the test or registered for it in Lithuania, National Public Health Center specialists will do so for them. The travelers will be monitored, and if they chose not to get tested, they will be subject to administrative liability, as the test is mandatory.**
