

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCEDURE FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE STUDY PROCESS AND THE STUDY PREREQUISITES

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Description of the Procedure for the Organization of the Study Process and the Study Prerequisites (hereinafter as – Description) determines the procedure of studies for students and teachers at Lithuanian University of Health Sciences (hereinafter as – LSMU or University).
2. This description of the procedure shall not contradict the provisions of the LSMU study regulation and shall apply to the first, second cycle, integrated study programmes' students and listeners.

II. STUDY PREREQUISITES AND ORGANIZATION OF THE STUDY PROCESS

3. Contact activities at the University are planned to be carried out in the following order:
 - 3.1. A student shall fill the consent to the declaration on the procedure of the study prerequisites in force in personal data profile at LSMUSIS.
 - 3.2. In the Declaration, the student shall indicate that he/she agrees to the prerequisites for study and confirms that he/she meets one of the four criteria for participation in the study process (**1.** He/she has been vaccinated with one of the following COVID-19 (coronavirus infection) vaccines: one week following administration of the second dose of Comirnaty or Spikevax according to the vaccination plan; two weeks after administration of COVID-19 vaccine Janssen; 4 weeks but no more than 13 weeks after administration of the first dose of Vaxzevria; after administration of the second dose of Vaxzevria vaccine according to the vaccination plan; two weeks after administration of a single dose of Comirnaty, Spikevax or Vaxzevria vaccine to a person with a history of COVID-19 (coronavirus infection) in case the diagnosis was confirmed based on a positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test result; one week after administration of the second dose of Comirnaty or Vaxzevria vaccine, if Vaxzevria was used for the first vaccine, and Comirnaty vaccine for the second or vice versa. **2.** After being sick with COVID-19 (coronavirus infection) when the diagnosis was confirmed by a positive SARS-CoV-2 PCR test or antigen test result, and no more than 210 days have passed since the positive test (but not before the end of

the set isolation period). **3.** The student has received a positive (less than 60 days prior to detection of anti-S, anti-S1 or anti-RBD IgG antibodies to SARS-CoV-2) quantitative or semi-quantitative serological immunological test response, unless the serological test is performed after vaccination with COVID-19 disease (coronavirus infection) vaccine. 4. A COVID-19 test has been carried out with the negative result, at least 48 hours (from the time of sampling) following a SARS-CoV-2 PCR test”);

3.3. A student who does not agree with the study prerequisites provided in the declaration may exercise the right provided for in Section IV of Chapter VIII of the Study Regulation.

3.4. A student shall undertake to inform the dean of the faculty about the change of his /her status, which is related to the fulfillment of the study prerequisites, as soon as possible, but no later than within 1 day.

3.5. Upon receipt of this information, the staff of the dean’s office shall cancel the student’s declaration of compliance with the study prerequisites in the LSMUSIS system.

3.6. In order to ensure proper organization of studies and a safe environment, the University reserves a right to randomly check the student’s declared compliance with the study prerequisites (during the classes the student shall have a document proving the compliance with study prerequisites).

3.7. If during the inspection a student’s misconduct to the established procedure is to be found, the penalties provided in the Study Regulation shall be applied, and the student may no longer participate in contact activities. According to the provisions of Clause 108 of the Procedure of the Study Regulation, a student who has missed more than 25 % contact work hours subject (module part) must repeat this subject (module part).

3.8. A student’s contact activities, practice, clinical practice, planned to be carried out in medical institutions, shall be organized in accordance with the description of this procedure.

III. FINAL PROVISIONS

3.9. This Description shall be followed by all departments of the University conducting and administering studies at the University.

4. Personal data specified in the Description shall be processed in accordance with Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and other legislation on secure processing of personal data.

- 4.1. Personal data shall be processed in order to ensure a safe and compliant with the requirements environment for contact studies at the University, student internships and clinical practice in healthcare facilities.
- 4.2. Personal data shall be processed for the purpose specified in the Description in order to fulfill the obligation established by legal acts. Personal data shall be collected directly from students.
